

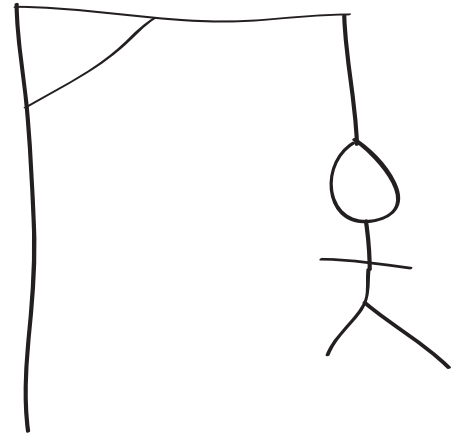
Hangman

Equipment

- Paper
- Pen or pencil

How to Play

First, one person is chosen to be the 'host' or the person who chooses the word the other player guesses.



Next, the 'host' draws a blank line for every letter of their chosen word. For example, if the 'host' chose the word CAT, they'd write three blank lines (_ _ _)

Then the players guess letters that could be included in the word. If they guess correctly, the letter is written on the appropriate lines, meaning that if all letters are guessed correctly the word is spelt out. For example, if the 'host' chose the word CAT and the player guessed the letter A, they'd put the letter A on the middle blank (_ A _). If there are multiples of the same letter in the word, fill out all letters. For example, if the 'host' chose the word GOOD and the player guessed O, both Os would be filled out (_ O O _)

If they guessed incorrectly, the letter of the alphabet they guessed is crossed off a list and the 'host' draws the first part of the hanged-man.

To draw the Hangman:

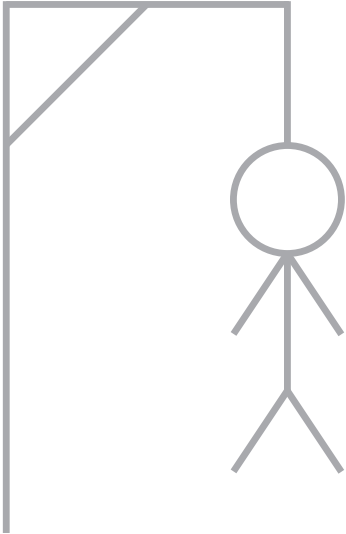
First draw the cross beam which looks like an upside down 'L'
Second, draw a short vertical line off the end of the top line for your 'noose'.

Third, draw a circle for the head.

Finally, draw each individual body part, i.e. arms and legs. For younger players, a face can be added with the eyes and mouth added individually.

To win the game, the player must either guess the word or all the letters in the word before the hangman is fully drawn.
